Day of Departure

Monday, July 1st

- Meet at Gangway at 9:30am for Team Devotion and Breakfast
- Drive to MIA Airport 10:30am (WA School Bus)
- Check-in at 11:30am and eat lunch (Need Spending \$\$\$)
- Departure to LAX 2:25pm (AA2283)
- Arrive in LAX 4:58pm and go to International Terminal
- Check-in with Fiji Airways then eat dinner (Need Spending \$\$\$)
- Departure to Nadi, Fiji 11pm (FJ811)

Day of Return to LA

Monday, July 15th

- Quiet time, team meeting, worship/devotions, free time and packing (Spending \$\$\$ optional)
- Early dinner
- Check-in 6:30pm and Departure 9:40pm (FJ910)

Monday (US), July 15th

- Arrive 1:25pm to LAX
- Check-in at hotel
- Team outing and dinner (Need Spending \$\$\$) then Team meeting (debrief)

Day of Return to FL

Tuesday, July 16th

- Breakfast at hotel 7:30-8:30am and check-out 9:30am
- Take Airport shuttle to Domestic Terminal
- Check-in 10am and grab something to eat before boarding (Need Spending \$\$\$)

Packing (luggage will go all the way through MIA to NAN) – Review packing list in team manual

- Carry-on dimensions: 50cm (height) x40cm (width) x 23cm (depth) - max. 15 lbs
 - Pack 2 pairs of extra clothes (you may want to change for the international flight and you may need an emergency set in case there's a hiccup with baggage)
- Check-in: max. 50 lbs
 - Bring a few gifts (Florida souvenirs or something of spiritual encouragement to give out to your EE trainees and/or youth that you meet)
 - Converter – Fiji operates on 240 voltage

Spending Money

- Bring cash to exchange (wait until we are in Fiji to exchange money)
- Most places take credit card, usually VISA. But most places also accept Discover and Mastercard. Please note that some places will not take American Express. Be aware that there is usually a 2-3% processing fee when using a credit card.
- Debit cards can be used at the ATMs but be aware there is an international fee.
- Money can be sent through Western Union at Publix with a fee.
- 2 airport meals (Lunch on July 1st and Lunch on July 16th) and 4 meals in town
- 3 (optional) opportunities to spend \$ during our excursions
- 5 (optional) opportunities to shop in town (souvenirs, gifts, snacks, etc.)

Roles
